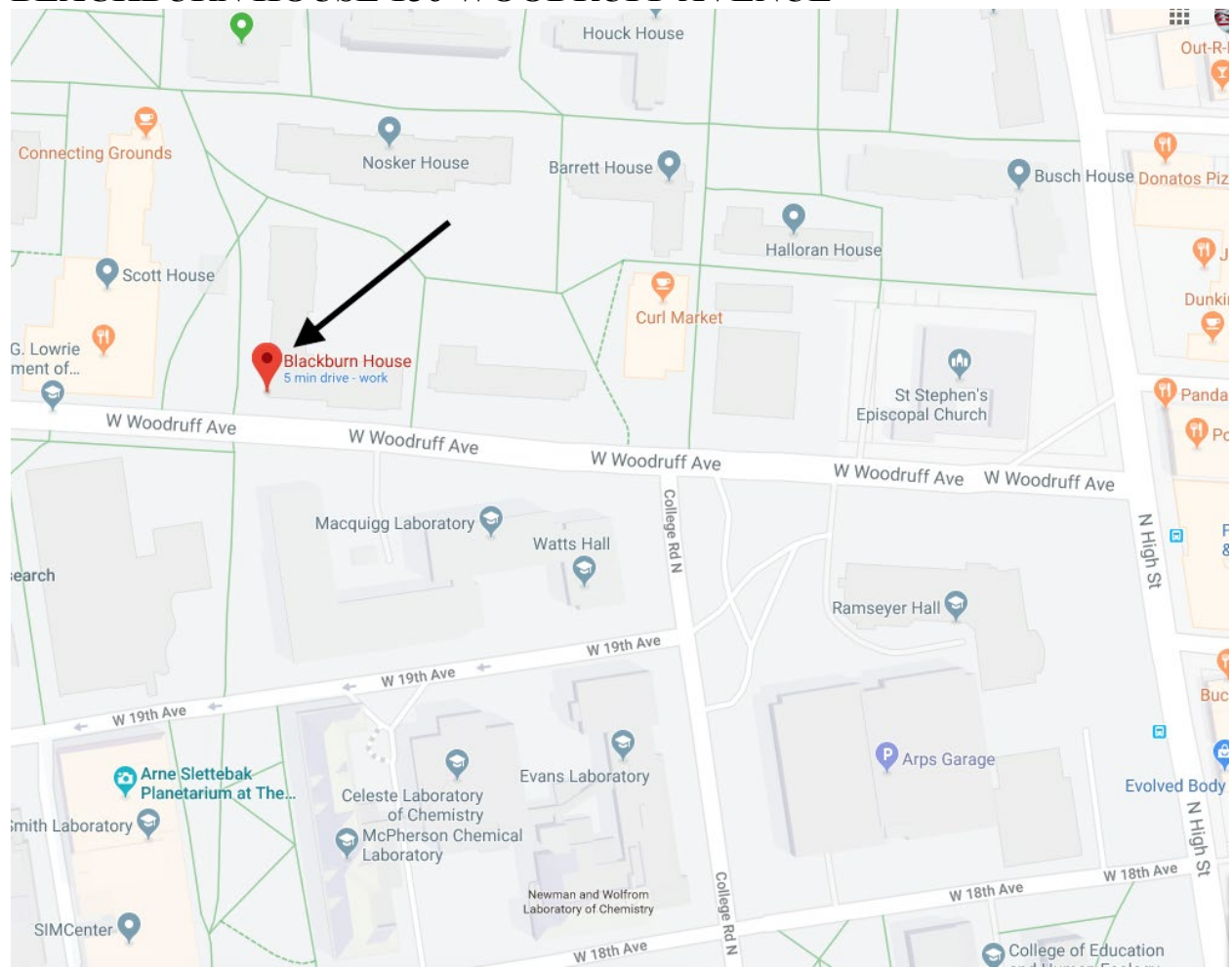
**Orientation for Dorm Residents and Commuters: 5:30-8:30pm**

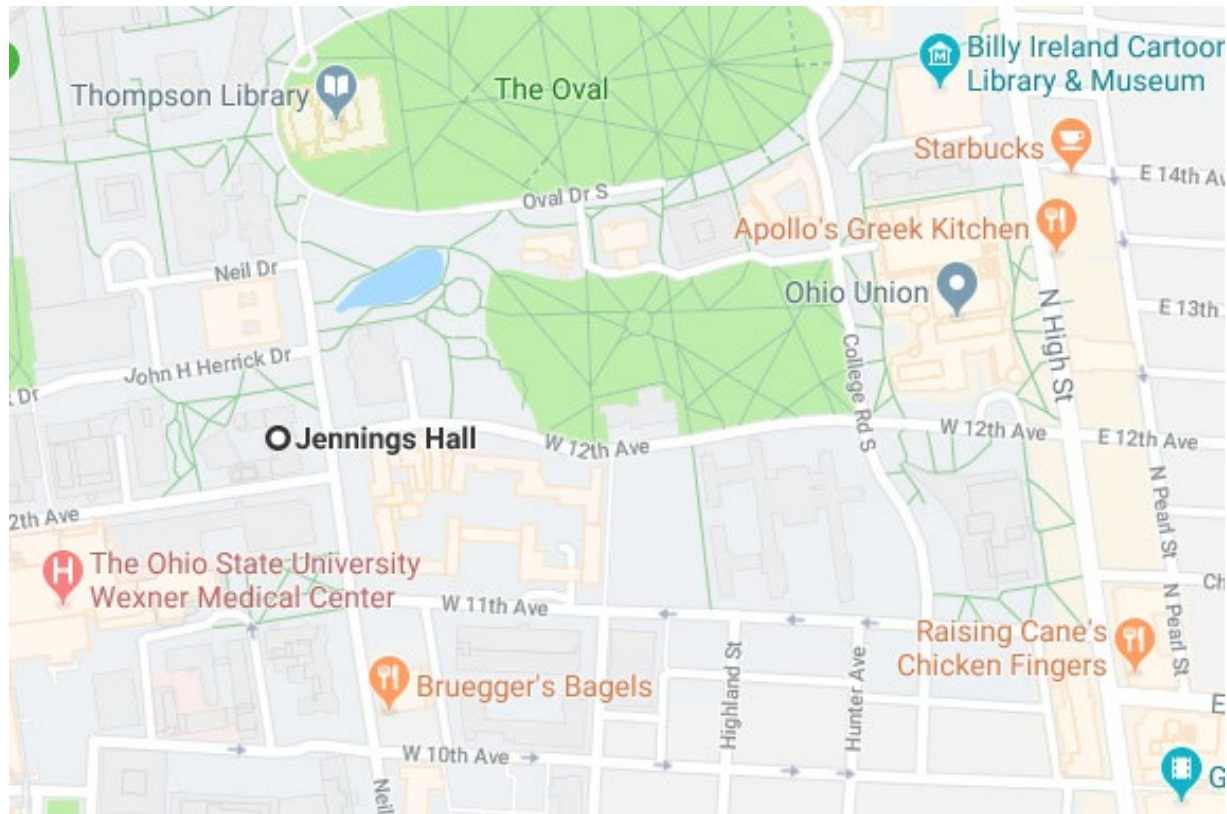
**LUNCH:** Commuters, please pack a lunch or bring enough cash (\$6-\$9) to purchase lunch at a local restaurant.

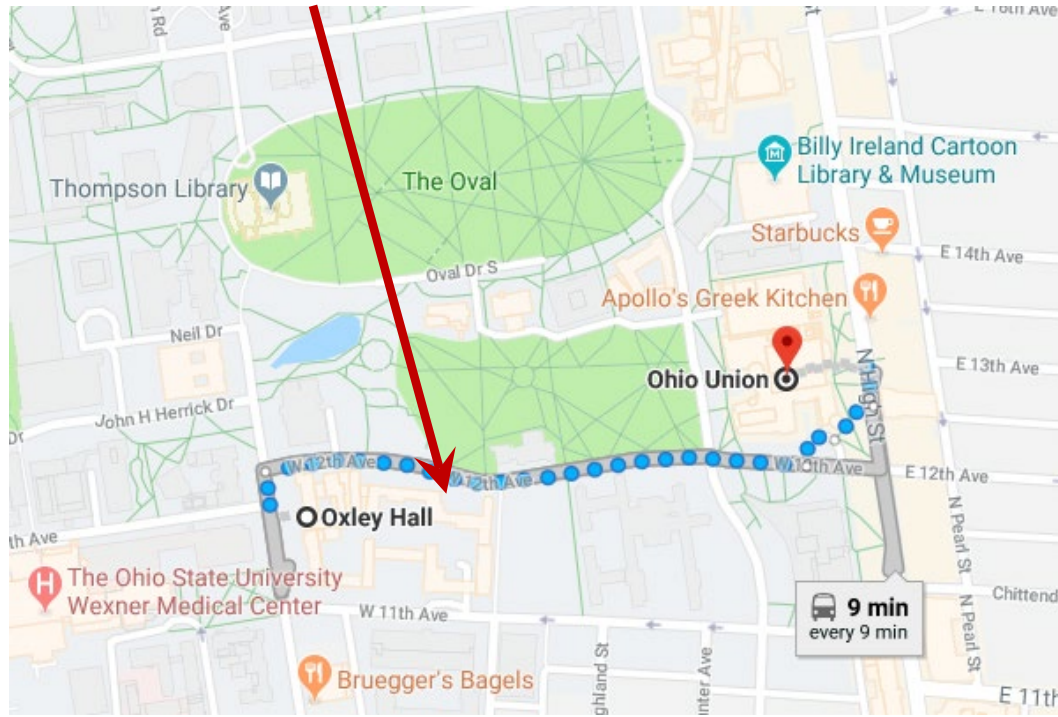
